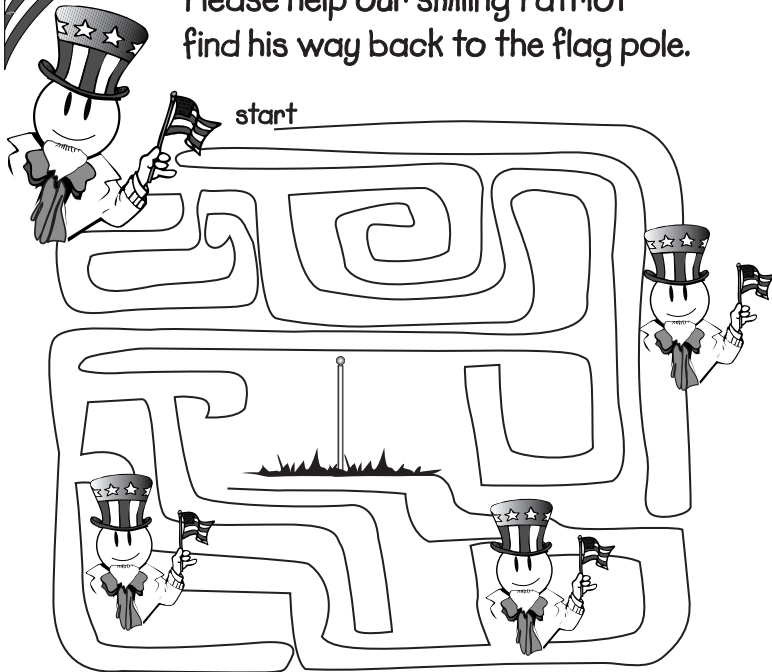

Just as there were 13 original colonies there are 13 words hidden in the puzzle above. How many can you find?

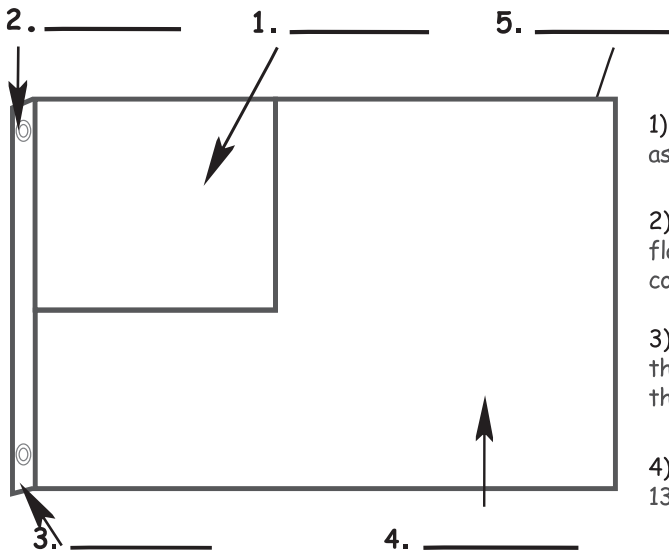

FLAG MATCH UP

Match the description of the historical flag on the left with the picture on the right.

- 1) GADSDEN- Hint: The image on this flag served as a warning to the British. a. 
- 2) BETSY ROSS- Hint: The first official American flag. The star arrangement symbolizes that no state comes before another. b. 
- 3) TAUNTON- Hint: This flag told the British that the Colonies wanted to be free to make their own laws. c. 
- 4) GRAND UNION- Hint: This flag symbolized the 13 colonies united under England's rule. d. 
- 5) KINGS COLORS- Hint: This flag served as the standard for the United Kingdom and all her colonies. e. 
- 6) STAR SPANGLED BANNER- Hint: The US had 15 states when this version of our flag inspired Francis Scott Key to write our national anthem. f. 
- 7) BENNINGTON- Hint: Reproductions of this early American flag were very popular during our nation's bicentennial in 1976. g.
